Under “Families First,” transportation offices will use a “Best Value” approach that focuses on performance. The majority of the moving business will be awarded to transportation service providers who do the best work as measured by the customer.

All current Arpin Group staff involved with military household goods will transition into the

Military Operations Center and will operate under the new SDDC business rules by May 2007. Staff will also use the new SDDC Defense Personal Property System (DPS), which is a centralized Web-based system that provides the convenience of 24/7 access to personal property shipment information and serves as a conduit for a direct relationship between DOD members and transportation service providers throughout the entire moving process.

Arpin Group, Inc. also continues to add special military spouse representatives at bases throughout the globe to implement the "Families First" program, supporting military families during moves.
